DT - Our main project will be recreating a Stone Age camp using different resources and also creating Stone Age jewellery and pots.

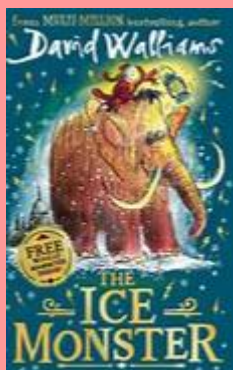
Geography - learning all about the Local Area and Volcanoes
